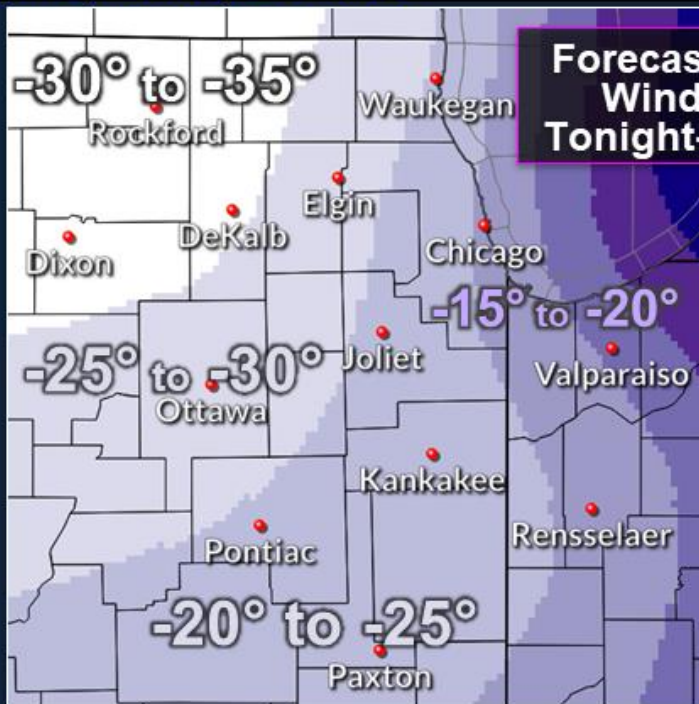

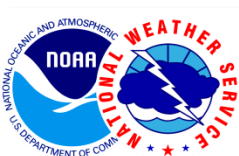


- Sub-zero wind chills through the weekend.

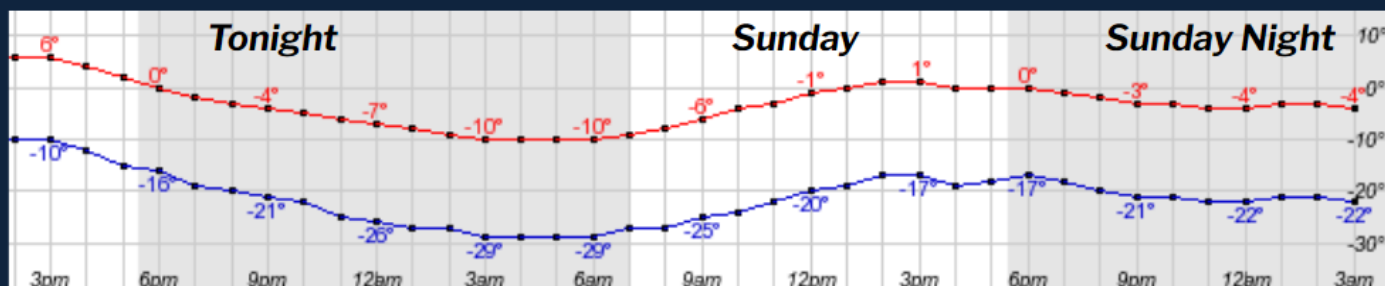

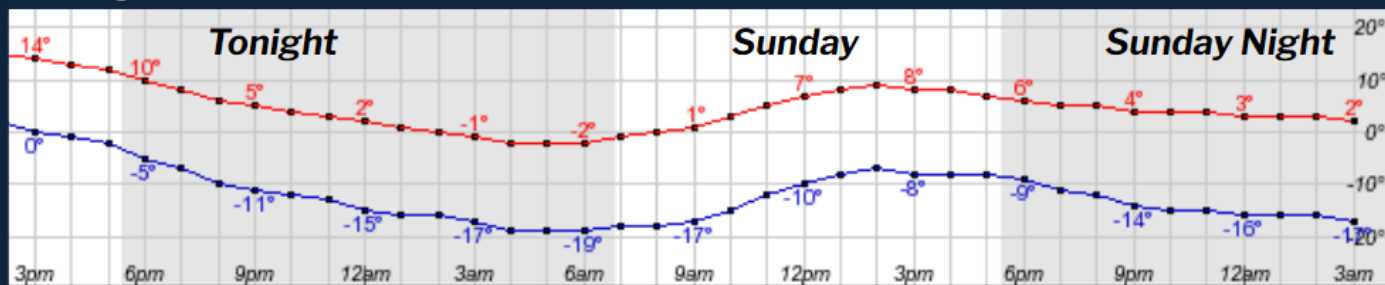

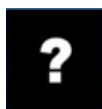

Through the Weekend, though the coldest period is expected tonight into Sunday morning.

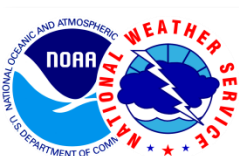

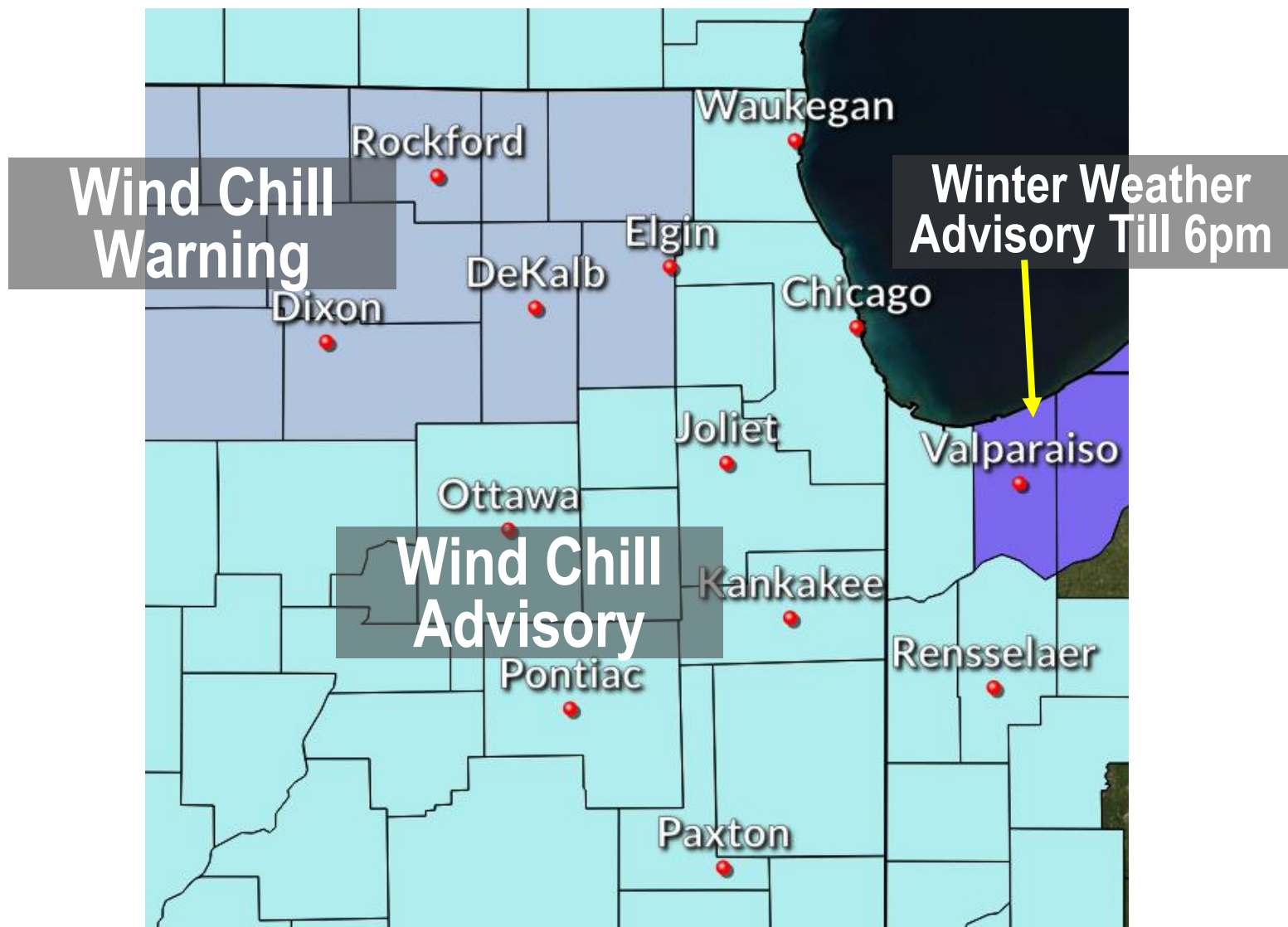

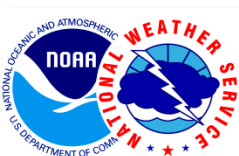
Dangerous Wind Chills This Weekend

Wind Chill Headlines: Tonight-Sunday Morning.



NWS Headline Definitions

- **Wind Chill Warning** in effect for north Central IL (Fox Valley and west) Valid: 6pm this Eve through Midday Sunday.
- **Wind Chill Advisory** in effect for the rest of northern IL and most of northwestern IN. Valid: Late this Eve through Midday Sunday.
- **Winter Weather Advisory** continues for Porter County Indiana today due to locally heavier lake enhanced snowfall amounts of 3 to 6 inches.

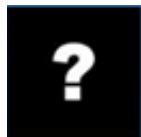

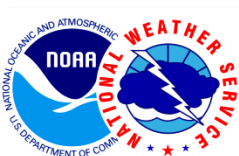
